TAX RECEIPT LOOKUP

Ready to prepare your taxes, but can't find your tax receipt? Manitowoc County is now using a new tax collection system that allows taxpayers to look up and print tax receipts online the day after it's paid. Follow the directions below to access your receipt:

1. Go to <https://ascent.co.manitowoc.wi.us/LandRecords/PropertyListing/RealEstateTaxParcel#/Search>.
2. Choose your municipality in the drop-down menu.
3. Enter your name, address, or parcel number.
4. Click the red "Find Now" button in the lower right-hand corner.
5. Click the red parcel number of the property you would like to view.
6. Click on a red Tax Year for specific detail, which will bring up a new popup window.
7. In the top right corner click "Printer Friendly" to print your receipt.

WATER SOFTENER INSPECTIONS

The first inspection for all softeners is **due May 1, 2024**. A Water Softener Inspection Form is available on the village's website: saintnazianz.org or at the village office. Please return your inspection documentation to the village once your softener is inspected.

DOG & CAT LICENSES

It is time to renew your pet licenses for 2024. Certificates of current rabies vaccination must be presented when obtaining a license. To license your pet, please either mail the rabies certificate, license fee, and self-addressed stamped envelope or bring the rabies certificate and license fee to the village office.

Fees: \$5.00 for neutered male or spayed female; \$10.00 for intact pets

\$20.00 late fee per animal licensed after April 1, 2024.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETINGS

Regular meetings are held at **6:30 PM on the third Tuesday of each month** at the Village Hall. Special meetings and committee meetings are called as needed. All official village notices and village meeting notices are posted 24 hours in advance at the Post Office, Village Shop, and the Village Hall.

DIRECT PAYMENTS

Did you know St. Nazianz Utilities offers a direct payment service? You can have your utility payment deducted automatically from your checking or savings account. To take advantage of this convenient service, please fill out the Direct Payment Form which can be found on our village website and return it to the village office by mail or put it in the drop box located at 110 Colonial Drive.

ELECTIONS

Elections are held at the Village Hall, 228 West Main Street. You can either register online at myvote.wi.gov, early registration in-person at the village office, or in-person on Election Day. You must provide proof of residence and photo ID.

Election Schedule for 2024:

- Spring Election – Tuesday, April 2
- Partisan Primary – Tuesday, August 13
- General Election – Tuesday, November 5

GARBAGE CARTS

Garbage & Recycling pickup is every **Thursday at 6 AM**. GFL would like to remind you that need at least **3 ft. between carts and 3ft away from objects** such as: Fire Numbers, Mailboxes, telephone poles, etc. Please place your garbage and recycling carts **BEHIND** the curb, when possible, especially during inclement weather. This will allow the public works employees to operate their equipment more effectively.

REPORTING STREETLIGHT PROBLEMS

Do you have a streetlight that is not working properly? You can report the problem directly to WPS. Simply go to the WPS website: wisconsinpublicservice.com/secure/ssl/acct/street_light to complete and submit a short form. You will need the pole number, located on a metal plate on the pole (normally a 6-digit number-letter combination).
