WINTER / SNOW

Winter Parking Ban

No person shall leave standing any vehicle upon any village street between the hours of 1 AM and 6 AM from **December 1 through April 1**. This will be **strictly enforced** when snow removal equipment is in operation.

Snow Removal

A reminder to property owners who have a sidewalk on your property - you are responsible for keeping your sidewalk clear of snow and ice. **If the sidewalk is not clear**, village employees will clear it and the **cost will be billed to the property owner** unless other arrangements were made with the Village Board.

Mark Property Behind the Curb

If you have any shrubs, fences, etc. that are close to the curb or street, please mark them with posts and flags. Those operating snow removal equipment need to be aware that there is something buried under the snow. Manitowoc County will be doing our snow plowing this year.

General

- This is the time of the year for snow and ice problems on village streets; please cooperate with County and Village employees during this winter season.
- For safety reasons, please refrain from blowing or shoveling snow into the street.
- The village and county are **not** responsible for damage to lawns, etc. caused by snow removal.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETINGS

Regular meetings are held at **6:30 PM on the third Tuesday of each month** at the Village Hall. Special and committee meetings are called as needed. All official village notices and village meeting notices are posted 24 hours in advance at the Post Office, Village Shop and the Village Hall.

GARBAGE / RECYCLING

Garbage & Recycling pickup is every **Thursday**. Have carts on the curb by 6AM. GFL would like you to place your carts at least **three (3) feet apart** at the curb. Call the office if you have questions.

DOG & CAT LICENSES

Dog and cat licenses are due at this time for 2023. Certificates of current rabies vaccination must be presented when obtaining a dog or cat license.

Fees: \$5.00 for neutered male or spayed female; \$10.00 for unneutered male or unspayed female.

To license your pet, please either mail the rabies certificate, license fee, and self-addressed stamped envelope or bring the rabies certificate and license fee to the village office. (You can include license information with your tax payment.)

There is \$20.00 late fee per animal licensed after April 1, 2023.
