

February 17, 2026

The regular monthly meeting was called to order by President Gene Radder at 6:30 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Prayer was said by Radder.

Roll: Gene Radder, Rich Galien, Dan Gintner, Bob Schnell, Scott Stebnitz, Dan Stephani, and John Thews

Also present: Rebecca Abrams, Rob Baldwin, Chris Schaller, Bob Domagalski – St Nazianz Historical Society, and Boyd Philippi - Philippi Quality Construction

Minutes of the January 20, 2026, Regular Board Meeting were approved as presented. The motion was made by Stebnitz, seconded by Galien. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Thews, seconded by Gintner to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented and to pay Checks #22556 - #22598 and electronic payments in the amount of \$374,503.44. Motion carried.

There was no public input.

Boyd Philippi from Philippi Quality Construction was present to discuss the Village Hall exterior doors. The exterior door in the village office has failed and was leaking last summer. It is his recommendation that the village replace the existing doors with commercial-grade steel doors. The two doors will cost approximately \$5,000 total with a 4-5 week lead time. Philippi will put together a proposal for the board to consider at the March Board Meeting.

Bob Domagalski from the St Nazianz Historical Society was present to discuss their plans to have a mural painted on the south side of the Waniger Garage located at 102 N 4th Avenue. The board has no objections and there are no violations of village ordinances if the Historical Society were to have a mural painted on the side of the building.

The board reviewed the quote from Rural Insurance which included several updates to the village's policy. A motion was made by Stephani, seconded by Galien to update the policy as quoted.

The board reviewed a letter outlining several notations and stipulations for Bob Domagalski's Natural Lawn Permit. A motion was made by Gintner, seconded by Stephani, to approve the natural lawn permit subject to the notations and stipulations outlined in the letter. As noted in the letter, the village clerk will issue the permit upon receipt of the modified natural lawn management plan. Motion carried.

After reviewing the applications and completing background checks, Operator's Licenses were issued to Austin Ertel and Brenna Faber.

The Finance Committee is scheduled to meet on Tuesday, March 10 at 5:15 PM. The committee will meet to complete an employee review and to discuss changes to the recycling ordinance as required by the WI DNR.

Schaller shared that the village passed its February WET test. The Wastewater Treatment Plant ordered a new sludge pump. The board asked Schaller to request a "Dip" sign near Millers on Cty Hwy C.

A motion was made by Thews, seconded by Galien to approve the 4-year renewal agreement with HydroCorp. Motion carried.

Officer Baldwin shared a police activity report with the board. The squad underwent maintenance and repairs.

Radder gave an update regarding the May Village Association Dinner. He is organizing a listening session with local state and federal senators/representatives regarding various issues villages are having with the DNR.

Meeting adjourned at 7:17 PM.
